| Wearing the wrong assigned clothes, forgetting poms, uniform, outfit, etc. to an event. All must be in correct attire whether in class, at practice, at an event, cheering at a game, attending WE class, etc.  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1st -CONDITIONING</li> <li>2nd -CONDITIONING</li> <li>3rd -BENCH</li> </ul> <p><i>*Points may also be deducted from cheer class grade</i></p>  |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Failure to meet payment/fundraising deadlines</li> <li>(Varsity members may be required to pay out of pocket for competition fees, travel, etc. if he/she fails to meet fundraising requirements)</li> <li>Failure to maintain regular attendance in a tumbling class</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1st -CONDITIONING/WARNING</li> <li>2nd -BENCH</li> <li>3rd -BENCH</li> </ul>   |
| Inappropriate language, content, or comments on all electronic communications/social media of self or others  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1st - WARNING/ Parent Notification</li> <li>2nd - CONDITIONING</li> <li>3rd - BENCH</li> </ul>   |
| Insufficient knowledge of cheers and chants at practice, games, and event   | Will be benched until knowledge is proven   |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Disrespect to your coach, other coaches, teammates, other team members, administration, parents, game officials, teachers, etc.</li> <li>Inappropriate classroom behavior</li> <li>Improper notification of an absence (school or non-school related)</li> <li>Not having proper documentation to receive an excused absence</li> <li>Leaving practice, game, event, etc. without permission</li> <li>Assigned to ASD/ISS/OSS</li> <li>Unfavorable behavior as determined by the coaches and/or principals</li> <li>Unexcused absence from practice, event, game (including not contacting the coach)</li> <li>Talking or goofing off during the National Anthem</li> <li>Unsportsmanlike behavior</li> <li>Refusing to follow instructions given by one of the coaches at any time</li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1<sup>st</sup>- Bench</li> <li>2<sup>nd</sup>- Bench</li> <li>3<sup>rd</sup>- Bench</li> <li>4<sup>th</sup>- Subject to removal</li> <li>Coach and/or administration can place a cheerleader/mascot on probation or suspension at any time based off of the severity of the offense</li> <li>Coach will determine the event for the bench-normally, cheerleader will sit out at the next event.</li> </ul> |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Smoking, Alcohol, Drug Use</li> <li>Electronic Communication/Usage (computers, ipods, ipads, phones, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, SnapChat, MySpace, etc.) or any other form of electronic communication or social media.</li> <li>Unfavorable behavior as determined by the coach and/or principals</li> <li>Associated with smoking, alcohol, drug use, or inappropriate material of a sexual nature</li> <li>Bullying/harassing other squad members, other members of the program, or students</li> <li>DEAP</li> <li>any previous disciplinary/inappropriate behavior that is not reported to the coaches but may interrupt the integrity of the program</li> <li>non-removal of inappropriate piercings</li> <li>Visible tattoos</li> </ul>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>subject to dismissal</li> <li>If applicable, school consequences may occur for these offenses as well.</li> <li>Coach and/or administration can place a cheerleader/mascot on probation or suspension at any time based off of the severity of the offense</li> </ul>  |
| Grades ineligible for UIL   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>bench until next grade report</li> <li>twice may result in a mandatory tutorial schedule and/or dismissal</li> </ul>   |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nails-Fake nails, no shellac, or real nails longer than fingertip</li> <li>Paint on fingernails during events, competition, games, etc.</li> <li>Wearing jewelry or refusing to take a piercing</li> </ul>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1st-BENCH</li> <li>2nd-BENCH</li> <li>3rd-BENCH</li> </ul> <p><i>-Cheerleader/Mascot will not be able to participate until nails have been removed/cut. If cheerleader/mascot arrives to an event not following these guidelines, he/she will receive an immediate bench.</i></p> <p><i>-Cheerleaders may not cover up a new piercing with a Band-Aid. All jewelry must be removed.</i></p>                |

\*Procedures/consequences can be added to the chart by the coaches at any time.

**Bullying**-is when a student or group of students engages in written or verbal expression, expression through electronic means, or physical contact that occurs on school property, at a school-sponsored or a school-related activity, or in a vehicle operated by the district and a school district's board of trustees or the board's designee determines that the behavior:

\*Has the effect or will have the effect of physically harming a student, damaging a student's property, or placing a student in reasonable fear of harm to the student's person or damage of the student's property.

\*Is sufficiently severe, persistent, and persuasive enough that the action or threat creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for a student.

This conduct is considered bullying if it:

\*Exploits an imbalance of power between a student perpetrator who is engaging in bullying and a student victim through written or verbal expression or physical conduct.

\*Interferes with the student's education or substantially disrupts the operation of the school.
